RULES

1. FESTIVAL ORGANIZER

The Director of the Festival is the Deputy Director for Artistic Affairs of the "Maska" Theatre in Rzeszów. The festival is financed from the funds of the Municipality of Rzeszów and funds obtained for this purpose from grants.

2. TERM

The 13th International Festival of Theatres of Animated Forms "MASKARADA" will be held in Rzeszów from 4th to 8th June 2023. If restrictions are introduced in the organization of cultural events, the date of the Festival may be changed.

3. IDEA AND AIMS OF THE FESTIVAL

1) The main objectives of the Festival are:

- presentation of the most interesting performances, which are the result of creative explorations in the sphere of puppet theatre, broadly understood animated form and art of animation and inscribed in the theme of the Festival: also broadly understood as becoming familiar with fear and difficult emotions, getting used to one's own identity, taming animals, taming/getting to know the unknown,
- presentation of new trends in theatre for children and young people,
- creating a place for the exchange of ideas, experiences and views on the theatre of animated form between artists and the audience,
- promotion of the "Maska" Theatre in the theatre environment.

2) "Maskarada" 2023 will take the form of a meeting/review of performances. It will not be a competition.

3) Only performances for children or young people will be qualified for the Festival programme.

4) During the Festival, the Organizer's performances related to the theme of the 13th edition will also be presented. Please do not submit titles that are in the repertoire of the "Maska" Theatre (www.teatrmaska.pl – PERFORMANCES tab).

5) The "Maskarada" program will also include workshops, an interactive doll exhibition, a street parade, a social action organized with the Homeless Animal Shelter "Kundelek" in Rzeszów, etc.

4. QUALIFICATION

The festival is an event in which professional – institutional theatres can participate and non-institutional, and students of higher theater schools. Theatres interested in participating in the Festival are obliged to send an application containing the following to koordynator@teatrmaska.pl:

- a link to the recording of the entire submitted performance,
- completed Application Form (separately for each submitted performance),
- information about the performance (promotional materials, description, reviews, etc.) and the theater,
- minimum 5 photographs in print quality (please provide the name and surname of the photographer),
- detailed technical rider,
- hotel list.

Application deadline: 31 January 2023.

Qualification of festival performances takes place on the basis of materials sent by the teams. The theatres will be informed about the preliminary results of the qualification by February 28, 2023. The date of final confirmation of which performances will be included in the Festival programme depends on the date on which the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage announces information on the co-financing of projects submitted to the Artistic Events for Children and Youth programme.

5. JURORS OF THE FESTIVAL – CHILDREN AND YOUTH.

The festival is non-competitive. No financial prizes will be awarded. Instead, a Children's and Youth Jury will be appointed, which will be the voice of the viewers, the main recipients of the Festival: children and youth. It will award honorary prizes to the best, in their opinion, performances.

7. THE ORGANIZERS PROVIDE:

- Accommodation for the time of active participation in the Festival,
- meals (breakfasts and dinners) for the duration of the Festival,
- fee for the performance determined individually with the qualified team,
- technical assistance and necessary conditions for the presentation of the performance,
- promotional materials.

Detailed rules of participation in the Festival are specified in the agreement.

8. DUTIES OF THEATRES

Accepting an invitation to participate in the Festival means agreeing to:

- free sharing and use of the submitted materials (photos, fragments of video recordings – up to 3 minutes) for promotional purposes,
- free taking of photos during the performance and registration of fragments of the performance by the organizer or persons authorized by him for documentation purposes and promoting the Festival,
- free recording of fragments of the performance by TV stations and Internet televisions, as well as free broadcasting – for promotional and advertising purposes – fragments of the show (up to 3 minutes),
- settling all financial receivables due to copyrights on their own,
- obtaining, at their own expense, all consents of persons participating in the submitted performance for the use of the image for the purpose of presenting the performance during the Festival and promotion and documentation of the Festival.

Sending the completed Application Card is an expression of acceptance of the Regulations and conditions of participation in the Festival.

9. RODO

In connection with the implementation of the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), hereinafter referred to as GDPR, in accordance with Article 13(1) and Article 14, we inform you about the principles of processing your personal data and your rights related to it.

1. The administrator of your personal data is the "Maska" Theatre in Rzeszów with its registered office at Mickiewicza 13, 35-064 Rzeszów.
2. Contact with the Personal Data Protection Inspector is possible at the following email address: iod3@erzeszow.pl or in writing at the address of the data administrator.
3. Personal data are processed in order to accept the application for 13. International Festival of Theatres of Animated Form "Masquerade", including the necessary contact – pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) – processing necessary for the purposes of the performance of the contract – the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2017.
4. 4. The recipients of your personal data will only be entities authorized to obtain personal data on the basis of legal provisions or an appropriate agreement with the administrator.
5. Your personal data will be processed for the period necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected, and after that time for the period and to the extent required by the provisions of generally applicable law m.in. the Act of 14 July 1983 on the national archival resources and archives.
6. 6. Providing your personal data is voluntary, but necessary to conclude contracts with you. The consequence of not providing personal data may be refusal to accept the application.
7. 7. In connection with the processing of your data by the "Maska" Theatre in Rzeszów, you have the right to:
 - a) access to the content of personal data and rectification (correction) in the event that personal data are incorrect or incomplete,
 - b) request the deletion of personal data (the so-called right to be forgotten) if:
 - the data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
 - the data subject has withdrawn consent to the processing of personal data, which is the basis for data processing and there is no other legal basis for data processing;
 - - the data subject has objected pursuant to Article 21(1) of the GDPR to the processing and there are no overriding legitimate grounds for the processing, or the data subject has objected pursuant to Article 21(1).2 the General Data Protection Regulation for processing,
 - personal data are processed unlawfully,
 - personal data must be erased in order to comply with the obligation arising from from the law;
 - c) lodging a complaint with the supervisory body competent in matters of personal data protection, which is the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (Stawki 2, 00-0193 Warsaw),
 - d) the right to request the restriction of the processing of personal data.
8. The data provided by you will not be processed in an automated manner or will not be profiled. There may be cases when the Administrator transfers your personal data to a third country or international organizations, you will be informed about each of these cases.
